ER SEIZURE/EPILEPSY patient general clinical work-up guideline & follow up

1. On arrival of patient - 1<sup>st</sup> time or breakthrough seizure  
 CT head w/to  
 CBC, Electrolytes  
 Urine drug screen if indicated  
 Anti-seizure medication level should be drawn if there is a question of compliance, drug-drug interactions, or the patient is pregnant  
 A prothrombin level does not need to be drawn

2. Admission Yes/No?  
 A patient with a first time seizure does not necessarily need to be admitted to the hospital:  
 Yes, if any of the below: \_\_\_\_\_ If NO admission(standard of care is):

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The patient has an injury due to the seizure (lacerated, fracture etc)</li> <li>The patient had multiple seizures</li> <li>The patient has a focal neurological deficit.</li> <li>Patient has not returned to baseline prior to ED discharge</li> <li>The patient is pregnant</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Out patient follow up with an epilepsy specialist within 14 days.</li> <li>Out patient EEG</li> <li>Out patient MRI brain</li> </ol> <p>*See below for when to refer to epilepsy clinic, #2 and #3 above will be handled by the clinic</p>

Any patient with a new diagnosis of seizures/epilepsy should be referred to the epilepsy clinic.  
 Any patient with an existing diagnosis of seizures/epilepsy and/or an anti-seizure medication should be offered a follow up in the epilepsy clinic, if they do not have /have not seen a seizure specialist.
