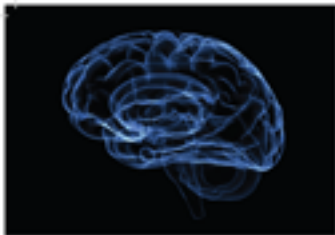

WHAT IS A STROKE?

A stroke is cell death due to interruption of blood flow to the brain. There are two types of strokes: ischemic and hemorrhagic.

An **ischemic stroke** is caused by a clot blocking blood flow to the brain. For patients experiencing this kind of stroke, tPA (Tissue Plasminogen Activator) a clot busting drug, may be a treatment option if symptoms are less than two hours old. The drug dissolves the blood clot causing the stroke.

A **hemorrhagic stroke** is caused by bleeding from a ruptured blood vessel in the brain. For patients experiencing this kind of stroke, tPA is not a treatment option.

TIME

The clock literally starts ticking upon the first signs of a stroke. Whether a patient arrives at the Emergency Department, or is already an inpatient at the hospital, physicians and staff immediately act as treatment is time dependent. Evidence based medicine shows there is a treatment window for maximizing outcomes for stroke patients. Knowing the time of the onset of stroke symptoms plays an important role in treatment options.

COMPREHENSIVE STROKE CENTER PROVIDES HIGH QUALITY CARE



Certified by the Joint Commission as a Comprehensive Stroke Center of Excellence, McLaren Flint's stroke program offers a continuum of care with intensive, critical and acute care services to patients, as well as inpatient and outpatient rehabilitation services. The research is clear; patients treated at certified comprehensive stroke centers, like McLaren Flint, experience better outcomes, including longer lives and fewer disabilities. McLaren Flint is also among a small percentage of hospitals across the country to offer a vascular interventional neuro program and is the first in the region to provide such services.

Our neurological physicians and staff members use a multidisciplinary approach to ensure each stroke patient receives the treatment that is right for him or her.
