What is Speech Therapy?

Speech therapy is a skilled treatment which may address difficulty communicating due to loss of speech and/or language, decreased cognitive function, difficulty swallowing and voice disorders.

What are some symptoms of swallowing disorders?

- coughing during or right after eating or drinking
- wet or gurgly sounding voice during or after eating or drinking
- extra effort or time needed to chew or swallow
- food or liquid leaking from the mouth or getting stuck in the mouth
- recurring pneumonia or chest congestion after eating
- weight loss or dehydration from not being able to eat enough

We now offer Videostroboscopic Exams

A videostroboscopic exam is a painless, outpatient procedure which is performed to look at the function and motion of the vocal folds. This exam provides useful real-time information concerning the nature of vocal fold vibrations and images to better detect vocal pathology.
