McLAREN SAFETY FIRST is our System-wide Electronic Reporting Program that is used to help capture, identify and address Safety Risks while continuing to promote a culture of transparency and patient safety.



By reporting events in McLAREN SAFETY FIRST, we are able to share this information system-wide, implement process improvements and ensure that our patients are receiving the best possible care in the safest environment.

Example of events and concerns that should be reported:

- **Delay in Care:** STAT imaging/lab orders not being completed in a timely fashion.
- Infection Issues: Hospital / Facility acquired illnesses, ulcers, etc.
- **Near Misses/Other Safety Concerns:** Potential events/mistakes that occurred but did NOT reach the patient and have potential for harm:
 - Medication Errors (incorrect medication/dosage/rate prepped but caught prior to administration
 - Incorrect Boarding for Surgery (Incorrect site/body part/patient) caught prior to surgery)
 - o Patient on fall protocol attempts to get out of bed, begins to fall but is caught by RN.
- **Equipment Issues:** Helps to identify trends in user error as well as potential faulty/malfunctioning equipment.
- Security/ Safety Issues: patients leaving AMA/Elopement, patients violent towards staff, etc.
- Patient Identification and/or Consent Issues
- Visitor Falls/Injuries
- Employee/Staff Injuries
