

Lung Cancer Screening PATIENT CHECKLIST

Do I qualify for a lung cancer screening?

- Lung cancer screening isn't right for everyone. You are eligible for a low-dose CT lung cancer screening if you meet these criteria:
- □ I am between 55 and 77 years of age
- □ I am a current smoker or quit smoking within the last 15 years
- I have smoked at least 30 pack years A pack year is defined as smoking an average of one pack of cigarettes per day for one year. A person can have a 30 pack year history by smoking one pack a day for 30 years or two packs a day for 15 years.
- I have not had lung cancer and have no symptoms of lung cancer
 - If you meet these eligibility requirements, talk to your doctor about your risk for lung cancer and whether a screening test is right for you.

If you and your doctor determine that a screening is appropriate, ask your doctor to schedule a low-dose CT lung cancer screening at McLaren Oakland by calling (248) 338-5604.
