Inpatient Sub-acute Detoxification and Short-term Program:

Sub-acute detoxification and short-term residential services at McLaren Oakland include medically supervised care provided in a residential setting for the purpose of managing the effects of withdrawal from alcohol, opiates, and other drugs for individuals 18 years of age and older. In addition, our program provides education and recovery based group sessions, individual sessions, medication management and discharge planning to support you in your recovery.

The program is staffed 24 hours per day, seven days a week by a comprehensive clinical team comprised of psychiatric and internal medicine physicians, psychologist, registered nurses, social worker, addictions counselor, recreational therapists, and behavioral health technicians to ensure appropriate assessment, safe detoxification, medical stabilization, and coordination of care. Most persons stay in the hospital between 4-10 days.

Most insurances are accepted.

The Addiction Recovery Center at McLaren Oakland offers hope to individuals and families struggling with addiction. Providing hospital based detoxification services, short-term hospital residential services, and intensive outpatient services, the clinical staff work with individuals and with their families to develop an effective plan for recovery. With the understanding that each person's circumstances are unique, this plan is designed to meet the specialized needs of the person seeking help.
