COUMADIN (Warfarin)

Anticoagulant

WHAT DOES IT TREAT?

Blood thinner used to prevent clots from forming or growing larger in the blood and blood vessels

Prescribed for people with irregular heart beat (such as A-fib), prosthetic heart valves, and those who have had a heart attack

MOST COMMON SIDE EFFECTS:

(Discuss with your doctor if these worsen or persist) Excessive bleeding (if you cut yourself), gas, change in the way things taste, tiredness, pale skin, loss of hair, feeling cold or chills

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Consistent diet of vitamin K containing foods such as spinach or cranberry juice

Blood will need to be drawn to evaluate levels (PT/INR) to ensure blood is thin enough to be effective
