

HOW TO PREPARE FOR YOUR DIAGNOSTIC TEST

Preparing for diagnostic testing is important. Each type of imaging exam and diagnostic procedure has its own specific guidelines. Specific instructions for your exam will be given at the time of scheduling. The following guidelines apply to all exams:

- Discuss any special needs or physical limitations prior to your test
- Wear loose, comfortable clothing without metal buttons, zippers
- Arrive 15 minutes early to verify your registration information

WHAT TO BRING

- Prior X-rays or scans, if you are instructed to do so
- Physician referral
- Current medical insurance card(s)
- Driver's license or other government issued identification

ABOUT APPOINTMENTS

Most tests are scheduled within 48 hours. We accommodate patients who require urgent testing.


