MSK Ultrasound uses sound waves to produce pictures of muscles, tendons, ligaments, nerves and joints throughout the body, allowing real-time diagnosis.

INDICATIONS FOR MSK ULTRASOUND:

- Shoulder Rotator Cuff and Bicep Tendon Pathology
- Elbow Ligament and Tendon Pathology
- Wrist/Hand Ganglion Cysts and Synovitis and Tenosynovitis
- Hip Hamstring Pathology
- Knee Quadriceps & Patellar Tendon Rupture
- Foot and Ankle Evaluate Achilles and other tendons
- Evaluate for Morton's Neuroma and bursitis
- Evaluate for plantar fasciitis or plantar fascia rupture
- Conventional radiographs of the foot and/or ankle
- CT foot and/or ankle with 3-Dimensional reconstruction


ADVANTAGES OF MSK ULTRASOUND:
