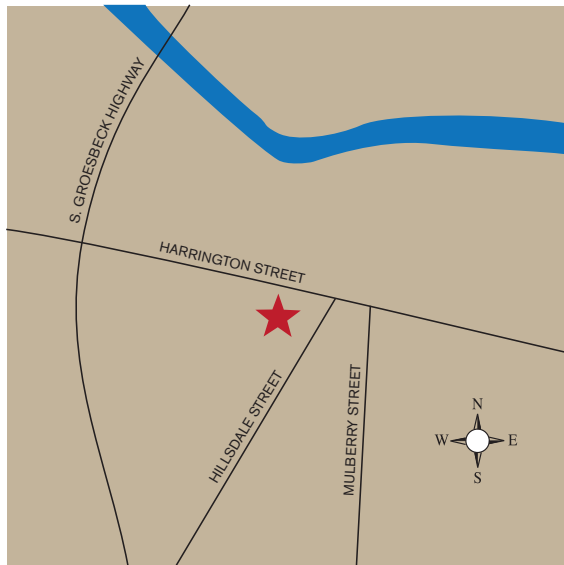

Primarily, we accomplish this with interventional therapies such as steroid injections. We often recommend physical therapy as well. We view continual medication management as a last resort. We aim for you to return to your life free of the constraints of pain.

WHAT TO EXPECT

At the initial evaluation you will be asked to provide a complete medical history. Be prepared to bring all pertinent information such as:

- Past medical problems
- Medication history
- Previous surgeries
- Other interventions

You will be evaluated by our staff and a treatment plan will be developed for you.

Be advised that we consider the initial visit as “starting from scratch.” Previous treatments, including medications, will be assessed individually and not necessarily continued. We will provide the treatment plan that we consider best suited for you.

Most procedures are performed under fluoroscopy (X-Ray) as an outpatient at McLaren Macomb Hospital. IV sedation is offered to provide relaxation during your procedure.
