Hearing loss and cochlear implants: Evaluation and management of hearing loss for both children and adults including surgical and implantable options and audiological services. We are the only center in the region to offer diagnostic hearing evaluation to newborns and children in addition to medical and surgical care.

Chronic ear infections and cholesteatoma: Medical and surgical evaluation and care of chronic ear disease.

Dizziness and balance disorders: Assessment and care of patients of dizziness with imbalance disorders, including medical and surgical treatments of Meniere's disease, vestibular migraine, and BPPV, among others.
