TREATMENT

We offer a full continuum of care with multiple specialty services and state-of-the art equipment.

Patients are typically seen 2-3 times per week for one-on-one sessions with their therapist.

On your first visit, you will be seen by a licensed therapist for an individual evaluation. Your therapist will develop and monitor a treatment plan that is tailored to meet your unique needs. You will be scheduled for a series of one-to-one therapy sessions.

REHABILITATION TEAMS

All of our clinicians are licensed professionals and include physical therapists, occupational therapists, speech & language pathologists and physical therapist assistants. Regardless of the injury or illness, no two patients are alike. A team of experienced and highly trained specialists develop and monitor a treatment plan that is tailored to meet each patient's unique needs.

Ongoing communication between the patient, family and physician is emphasized. Throughout the course of outpatient treatment, our therapists monitor and evaluate the patient's progress and make adjustments to the treatment plan as needed for optimal outcomes.
