Medline 2% CHG Cloths

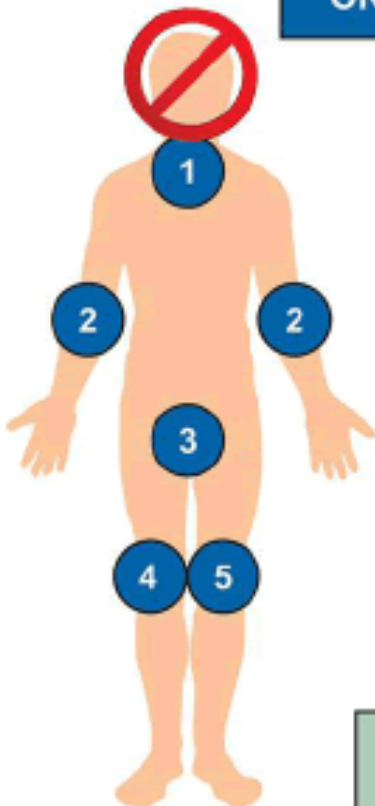

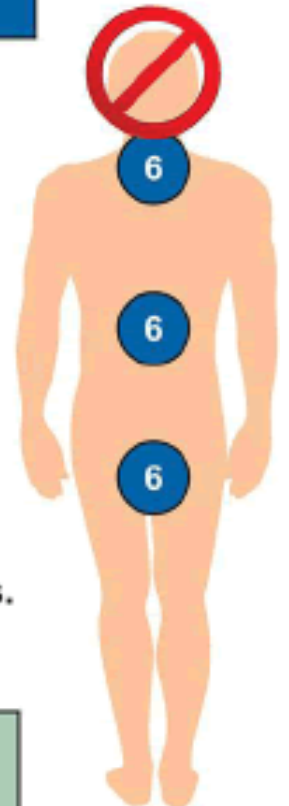
- These cloths reduce germs on the skin to help prevent infection after surgery. Use these cloths the night before surgery, after your bath or shower. Wash your body and hair normally with soap and shampoo first. Dry yourself thoroughly.
- Tear open first package and remove each cloth as you use it. Use one cloth to cleanse each of the 6 areas of the body shown below. Do not use CHG near your face. Firmly massage the skin with each cloth to remove bacteria. Discard used cloths in trash.
- Do not rinse off after applying; allow skin to air dry. Do not apply lotions or powders to your body after using CHG cloths.
- Sleep in clean pajamas and clean bed sheets/linen.
- Do not use on children under two months of age. Do not use if you have an allergy to chlorhexidine gluconate or have severe skin breakdown, rash or burns. Do not use on open wounds. Do not use near eyes, ears or mouth. If skin irritation occurs, rinse with water and contact your healthcare provider.

ONLY USE CHG CLOTHS *BELOW* THE JAWLINE



Front

- 1 Neck, shoulders, and chest.
- 2 Both arms and hands.
- 3 Abdomen then groin and perineum.
- 4 Right leg and foot.
- 5 Left leg and foot.
- 6 Back of neck, back, and then buttocks.



Back

Skin may feel sticky for a few minutes.
Do NOT wipe off. Allow to air dry.
