



WHAT IS A CERTIFIED NURSE MIDWIFE?

Certified nurse-midwives (CNMs) are registered nurses with masters degrees in nursing and special certification in nurse-midwifery. While CNMs independently manage the care of healthy patients, they have 24-hour access to board-certified obstetrics and gynecology physicians.

While most people equate CNMs with prenatal care and delivery, today more women are choosing CNMs as their primary care provider throughout childbearing years and through menopause.

- Annual gynecological exams
- Birth control education and prescriptions
- Nexplanon and IUD insertion
- First gynecological exam for teens, including education about their bodies and normal processes
- Preconception counseling and exams

- Postpartum care including postpartum depression and anxiety
- Breastfeeding education and support
- Menopausal care
- Testing and treatment for infection, including those that are sexually transmitted
