WHAT IS A PET-CT EXAM?
 A PET (positron emission tomography) scan creates an image of your body's metabolic activity and shows the rate at which your body's cells break down and use sugar (glucose). This is done by injecting a small amount of radioactive material into your bloodstream and waiting for it to disperse to the area of focus. The PET scan pictures are then performed to detect the radioisotope to create an image on the computer screen.
 A PET/CT combines the functional information from a PET scan with the anatomical information from a CT scan. When a CT scan is placed over a PET scan, doctors can pinpoint the exact location of abnormal activity. They can also see the level and extent of that activity. Even when an abnormal growth is not yet visible on a CT scan, the PET scan may show the abnormal activity. PET/CT scans are commonly used to find changes in the body during the early stages of the disease and for staging and restaging of cancers.
Safety: The dose of radiotracer administered is small, resulting in minimal radiation exposure. Nuclear medicine has been used for more than five decades and there are no known long-term adverse effects from such low-dose exposure. Allergic reactions to radiopharmaceuticals may occur but are extremely rare.
Female patients: Female patients between the ages of 10 and 55 will be required to provide a urine sample upon arrival. Women should always inform their physician or technologist if there is any possibility that they are pregnant or if they are breastfeeding.
