When a patient is referred to our clinic our physicians diagnose pain through a systematic approach including a staff consultation, physical examination, diagnostic testing, psychological testing and any other tests to determine the exact location and source. Once the source is diagnosed the team uses a variety of innovative approaches including:

- Facet Joint Injections
- Cervical, Thoracic, and Lumbar Epidural Injections
- Spinal Cord Stimulation
- Peripheral Nerve Stimulation
- Sacroiliac Injections
- Steroid Injections
- Intrathecal Drug Therapy/Pump Implants
- Trigger Point Injections
- Migraine Injections
- Radio Frequency Ablation
- Minimally Invasive Spinal Procedures (Interspinous Spacer & Kyphoplasty)
