## What are the risks of anesthesia?

While anesthesia is usually very safe, no procedure is without risk. Your anesthesiologist will discuss this with you prior to your procedure. Factors that affect your risk include your health, your history of anesthesia, the type of surgical procedure, or postoperative care. If you have any concerns with your anesthesiologist.

## After the procedure

When the surgery is complete, the anesthesia medications are stopped. You will be moved to the operating or recovery room. You'll probably feel groggy and disoriented.

## You may experience common side effects such as:

- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Dry Mouth
- Sore throat
- Shivering
- Sleepiness
- Mild confusion

You may also experience other side effects after you awaken from anesthesia. These include pain, nausea, and vomiting. Your doctor will discuss these with you and may prescribe a pain reliever or anti-nausea medication to reduce pain and nausea.
