The McLaren system includes 14 hospitals in Michigan and Ohio, ambulatory surgery centers, imaging centers, a 490-member employed primary and specialty care physician network, commercial and Medicaid HMOs covering more than 640,000 lives in Michigan and Indiana, home health and hospice providers, retail medical equipment showrooms, pharmacy services, and a wholly owned medical malpractice insurance company. McLaren operates Michigan's largest network of cancer centers and providers, anchored by the Barbara Ann Karmanos Cancer Institute, one of only 51 NCI-designated comprehensive centers in the U.S. McLaren has 26,000 employees and more than 52,500 network providers.

SUBSIDIARY PROFILES

McLAREN BAY REGION

Located in Bay City, Michigan, McLaren Bay Region is a 395-bed acute tertiary care hospital providing specialty, primary and preventive services including cardiovascular, neuroscience, orthopedics, oncology, women's health, rehabilitation, home health and hospice care, EMS, and more. McLaren Bay Region is proud to be a Primary Stroke Center and a Neuroscience Center of Excellence, as well as the only accredited Chest Pain Center in the Great Lakes Bay Region.

McLAREN BAY SPECIAL CARE

Located in Bay City, Michigan, McLaren Bay Special Care is a 31-bed long-term acute care hospital specializing in the care and treatment of patients with complex medical needs, including a ventilator weaning program, that require lengths of stay greater than 25 days. The experienced staff members are highly trained and use a team approach to provide intensive, individualized treatment. The hospital is licensed by the Michigan Department of Community Health and is accredited by The Joint Commission.

McLAREN CARO REGION

Located in Mount Pleasant Michigan, McLaren Central Michigan is a 118-bed acute care hospital which offers a full range of health and wellness services including primary care, general surgery, orthopedic surgery, emergency medicine and cancer services. McLaren Central Michigan is recognized as an accessible and dependable source of quality medical care for residents of Mount Pleasant, Isabella County and central Michigan. In addition to its medical staff of over 50 active physicians, it is affiliated with more than 150 other quality providers. The hospital is one of the region's largest employers, with approximately 550 employees and another 100 volunteers. McLaren Central Michigan received the Governor's Award of Excellence in 2017 and 2019 and is named as one of the Top 100 Rural & Community Hospitals in the United States by the Chartis Center for Rural Health. It is the only hospital in the central Michigan area to receive a Safety "A" grade in the Hospital Safety report in 2018, 2019 and 2020.

McLAREN CLARKSTON

McLaren Clarkston represents the largest ground-up development in the history of the corporation. The \$600 million health care village project, located on 95 acres of prime real estate in northern Oakland County, is being developed in two phases. Phase I opened in May 2009 and includes a 138,000 sq. ft. Medical Office Building, a 42,000 sq. ft. freestanding cancer center and a 5-acre Garden of Healing and Renewal.

McLAREN FLINT

Located in Flint, Michigan, McLaren Flint is a 378-bed tertiary teaching facility. McLaren Flint is affiliated with Michigan State University (MSU) College of Human Medicine in its medical and surgical residency programs, including family practice, internal medicine, general surgery, and orthopedic surgery. McLaren Flint also maintains fellowship programs in clinical health psychology, vascular surgery, minimally invasive surgery and cardiology in partnership with MSU. The hospital is certified as a Bariatric Surgery Center of Excellence, a Comprehensive Stroke Center (Joint Commission), and a BCBSM Blue Distinction Center+ for Hip and Knee Replacement and Spine Surgery, Cardiac Care and OB services. Cancer accreditations include the American College of Radiology Radiation Oncology Practice Accreditation and the Quality Oncology Practice Initiative, American Society of Clinical Oncology.

McLAREN GREATER LANSING

McLaren Greater Lansing, is a tertiary teaching facility with 240 acute care beds, located in Lansing, Michigan on the southern edge of the Michigan State University campus. McLaren Greater Lansing moved to the new hospital building located at the new healthcare campus on March 6, 2022. Among its services are a Level III Trauma Center/Emergency Department, Orthopedic and Sports Medicine Institute, comprehensive cardiac programs, medical/surgical units, and state-of-the-art women and children's health services including a modern birthing center. Also located at the healthcare campus is the Karmanos Cancer Institute at McLaren Greater Lansing and Outpatient Care Center.

McLAREN LAPEER REGION

Located in Lapeer, Michigan, McLaren Lapeer Region is a 222-bed acute care facility, and is a primary provider of health care services to Lapeer County and the surrounding area. McLaren Lapeer Region has received national recognition from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid for clinical excellence in orthopedics, pneumonia, congestive heart failure and surgical care. The facility maintains a verified Level II trauma designation and provides comprehensive care in a 29-bed Emergency Center along with specialized services for heart, cancer, orthopedic and general surgery services, physical medicine and rehabilitation, women's services, wound care services and sleep disorders.

McLAREN MACOMB

McLaren Macomb is a 288-bed acute care hospital located in Mount Clemens, Mich. More than 400 physicians and nearly 2,000 employees work at McLaren Macomb making it one of Macomb County's top employers. McLaren Macomb provides a full range of services, including cancer, surgical services, orthopedics and cardiovascular care. As Macomb County's first verified trauma center, the hospital operates the busiest emergency department in Macomb County. It is also an accredited chest pain center, a certified primary stroke center and an accredited bariatric and metabolic center. McLaren Macomb is a leader in graduate medical education, offering nine residency programs and three fellowship programs. McLaren Macomb has a rich history of providing high quality, compassionate health care and holds a strong position in the community it serves.

McLAREN PORT HURON

Located in Port Huron, Michigan, McLaren Port Huron is a 186-bed non-profit hospital. A community hospital founded in 1882, it has a strong history of providing quality, compassionate care to residents living in St. Clair and Sanilac counties and has earned repeated recognition for both clinical excellence and patient safety from nationally renowned health care rating organizations. McLaren Port Huron provides a full range of services, including cardiovascular care, cancer services, orthopedic care, and general, bariatric and robotic-assisted surgeries. Also available at the hospital are board-certified emergency physicians and nurses who staff the country's busiest emergency center, family birthing services and the only accredited sleep center in the region. In addition to its main campus in Port Huron, the hospital operates community health centers in Marysville, Yale, Lexington, and St. Clair.

McLAREN NORTHERN MICHIGAN

Located in Petoskey, Michigan, McLaren Northern Michigan is a 202-bed regional referral center, servicing residents in 22 counties across northern Lower Michigan and the eastern part of the Upper Peninsula. More than 230 physicians represent nearly all medical and surgical specialties, enabling full-service care with an emphasis on cardiology, cancer, orthopedics, and neurosciences. McLaren Northern Michigan has a network of primary care providers and specialty care clinics throughout the region, and an outpatient surgery center in Cheboygan.

McLAREN OAKLAND

McLaren Oakland is a 318-bed medical center that provides primary and specialty healthcare services to the greater Pontiac and Oakland County community. Founded in 1953, McLaren Oakland has grown to a comprehensive medical community that includes outpatient facilities in Clarkston and Oxford, in addition to an inpatient hospital in Pontiac providing a range of clinical services including emergency and trauma care, cardiology, cancer services, minimally invasive robotic surgery and orthopedic services. McLaren Oakland offers ACGME accredited residency and fellowship programs in anesthesiology, diagnostic radiology, emergency medicine, family medicine, internal medicine, orthopedic surgery, otolaryngology, pulmonary disease and critical care medicine, and transitional year, in addition to a CPME accredited podiatry program.

McLAREN THUMB REGION

McLaren Thumb Region is a not-for-profit provider of integrated healthcare. Founded in 1906 as Hubbard Hospital, it is a 58-bed full-service acute care hospital located in Bad Axe, Michigan. McLaren Thumb Region serves the residents of Huron, Sanilac and Tuscola counties and is committed to helping to shape the future of healthcare.

BARBARA ANN KARMANOS CANCER INSTITUTE

Barbara Ann Karmanos Cancer Institute is a leader in transformative cancer care, research and education through courage, commitment and compassion. As part of McLaren Health Care, Karmanos is the largest provider of cancer care and research in the state of Michigan. Our administrative and research headquarters, along with our premier specialty cancer hospital, are located in downtown Detroit. Our 16 network sites throughout the state deliver market leading cancer care and clinical trials conveniently to the communities where many of our patients live. Karmanos is recognized by the National Cancer Institute as one of the best cancer centers in the nation. Our academic partnership with the Wayne State University School of Medicine provides the framework for cancer research and education – defining new standards of care and improving survivorship.

McLAREN HEALTH PLAN (MHP)

The McLaren Health Plan has been operating as a Michigan-based licensed Health Maintenance Organization (HMO) since 1998, and today deliver health care benefits to 260,000 members. The HMO was started to serve Michigan's Medicaid population and has added group, individual and Medicare products along with a Third-Party Administrator called Health Advantage, Inc., for self-funded employer groups. In 2015, MHP was awarded the right to operate in and service every county in the lower peninsula of the State of Michigan – the only provider-owned health plan to achieve this designation by the Michigan Department of Community Health. MHP has earned the prestigious Pinnacle Award every year since 2013 from the Michigan Association of Health Plans and is also accredited by the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA).

MDWISE

MDwise is an Indiana-licensed non-profit health maintenance organization offering health care benefits to more than 300,000 Medicaid members. Since 1994, MDwise has provided access to compassionate, high-quality, coordinated health care and education to Medicaid members in communities across Indiana. A provider-owned health plan with a large network of doctors, specialists and hospitals located throughout the state, MDwise is accredited by the National Committee for Qualty Assurance (NCQA) accrediting body.

McLAREN HEALTH MANAGEMENT GROUP

McLaren Health Management Group provides home health, palliative care, hospice, home infusion, pharmacy, and comprehensive laboratory services across McLaren Health Care system's statewide network. Serving patients in more than 30 counties throughout Michigan, McLaren Health Management Group maintains corporate headquarters in Genesee County, Michigan with regional offices in Macomb, Ingham, Bay, Isabella and St. Clair counties.

McLAREN MEDICAL GROUP (MMG)

MMG manages the corporate ambulatory network consisting of more than 190 primary and specialty centers located throughout a 30-county region employing nearly 490 healthcare providers including physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants and nurse midwives. Its more than 300 physicians are among the top admitting and referring physicians for McLaren hospital subsidiaries. MMG has earned Patient Center Medical Home designation by Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan for many of these practices, and manages over 30 Rural Health Centers, providing primary healthcare in rural communities throughout Michigan.

McLAREN ST. LUKE'S

McLaren St. Luke's is a non-profit hospital in Ohio serving Maumee, Perrysburg and the surrounding communities in an accessible and comfortable suburban setting. Established in 1906, McLaren St. Luke's provides a wide range of traditional services, including cardiovascular, spine and neurological, robotic surgery, orthopedic, and emergency services with a dedicated Primary Stroke Center. McLaren St. Luke's has a Family Medicine Residency program that gives future family doctors a foundation of excellence based on leading edge treatments and time-tested principles.
