- Door In/Door out: 60 minutes
- RN to Create Record in Stroke Respond
- Page On Call Stroke Network 1-844-880-3500
- POC: Glucose 30 minutes
- ED LOS: <180 minutes from ED arrival to inpatient bed

STROKE QUALITY DOCUMENTATION TAB

- Yale Swallow Protocol- once, before any PO intake
- Learning Assessment- once, with Stroke Education Teaching
- Vital signs- hourly for activated strokes; q2 hours for non-activated (ESI Level 2)
- Neuro checks including Neurological Tab/ GCS/Pupils
- Neuro checks- hourly for activated strokes; q2 hours for non-activated (ESI Level 2)
- NIHSS on admission, once a shift, and if there's any changes.
- tPa and transfer documentation on Paper

TRAUMA VITAL SIGNS INCLUDE TEMPS, NEURO CHECKS

- Trauma Q 5m x 15m, then Q15m x 2H, Q30min x2H, then hourly
- Injured admitted Q1hr VS

Open Fx Antibiotics within 1 hr of arrival

ETOH/UDS ON ALL TTA

(If + and D/C home send with outpt resources)

DOCUMENT REASSESSMENTS

ED VITAL SIGNS

- ESI Level 1- VS's Every 5-15min x 4H, then hourly if stable
- ESI Level 2-VS's Every hour x 4H, then Q2H if stable
- ESI Level 3- VS's Q2H until stable, then Q4H
- ESI Level 4- VS's Q4H
- ESI Level 5- VS's at discharge
- All ED Patients Full set of vitals within 15 minutes of departure
