Dysarthria

Dysarthria is a motor speech disorder that can result in slurred or mumbled speech, speaking too slowly or too fast, and not being able to move your tongue, lips and/or jaw very well. The Speech-Language Pathologist will provide you with different strategies on how to be better understood. These strategies may include slowing down speech, using more breath to speak louder, and strengthening exercises stretching the muscles in the oral cavity as well as lips and tongue.

Voice Disorders Therapy

A voice disorder is when there is a change in how someone's voice sounds such as vocal quality, pitch, and loudness. Voice therapy involves establishing appropriate vocal hygiene, assessing structures that affect voice production, improving self-awareness of vocal quality and other contributing factors. The Speech-Language Pathologist will collaborate with you to determine
