**Subjective Placental Findings**

Abnormal umbilical cord length at term  
 Small or large placental size or weight for gestational age  
 Cord lesions: knot, thrombosis, single artery, torsion, absence of Wharton's jelly  
 Physical abnormalities: Infant, mass vascular thrombosis, retroplacental hematoma, abnormal coloration, opacification and malodor, abnormal shape  
 Marginal / velamentous cord insertion
