Important Message from Medicare

Your Rights as a Hospital Inpatient:

- You can receive Medicare covered services. This includes medically necessary hospital services and services you may need after you are discharged, if ordered by your doctor. You have a right to know about these services, who will pay for them, and where you can get them.
- You can be involved in any decisions about your hospital stay.
- You can report any concerns you have about the quality of care you receive to your QIO at: LVANEA 1-888-624-9906 or TTY 1-888-985-8775. The QIO is the independent reviewer authorized by Medicare to review the decision to discharge you.
- You can work with the hospital to prepare for your safe discharge and arrange for services you may need after you leave the hospital. When you no longer need inpatient hospital care, your doctor or the hospital staff will inform you of your planned discharge date.
- You can speak with your doctor or other hospital staff if you have concerns about being discharged.
