## Common Infectious Disease Diagnosis Include:

- Herpes Simplex Virus (HSV)
- Shingles
- Influenza
- HIV/AIDS
- Pre/post exposure prophylaxis for HIV/Hep C.
- Chronic hepatitis B/C.
- Post-operative infections, including prosthetic joint infections.
- Clostridioides Difficile (C. diff).
- Sexually transmitted infections.
- Fungal infections.
- Screening for Tuberculosis (TB), and management of active/latent TB.
- Skin and soft tissue infections.
- Counselling for travel vaccinations and COVID-19 related issues.
- Infection risk in immunocompromised patients.
