What is the Oncology Rehab Program?

Oncology rehabilitation professionals work with persons living with and beyond cancer to guide their exercise program before, during, and after treatment.

Oncology rehabilitation professionals use exercise and manual therapy to treat the adverse effects caused by cancer and cancer treatment, such as:

- Generalized weakness
- Balance impairments
- Chemotherapy-induced peripheral neuropathy
- Pain
- Gait dysfunction
- Decreased endurance
- Lymphedema
- Various other impairments

The goal of the Oncology Rehab Program is to provide the most comprehensive rehab care in the shortest amount of time necessary to achieve the desired outcome and improve overall quality of life.

What can my patient expect?

First appointment evaluates the patient's condition:

- Determines which impairment(s) the patient has, why it occurs, and what can be done to improve their condition.
- Includes a variety of tests and measurements related to the impairments.
- Takes about an hour.

Follow-up therapy appointments will focus on treating the impairments.

 Treatment and number of visits depends on the type of impairment and severity of the condition.

How can I refer my patient to Oncology Rehab?

- 1. Write a prescription for physical therapy for your patient.
 - Include a diagnosis (shoulder pain, general weakness, etc.) with a physical therapy ICD-10 code.
 - Add "oncology rehab" to the prescription.
- 2. Fax the prescription and the patient's last visit note to McLaren's Outpatient Rehab Clinic at:
