Spot the potential red flags:

-  He/She is fearful, anxious, depressed, submissive, tense or nervous/paranoid.
-  He/She seems malnourished.
-  He/She shows signs of physical/sexual abuse, physical restraint, confinement, or torture.
-  He/She has few or no personal possessions.
-  He/She is not in control of their own money.
-  He/She is not in control of his/her own identification documents (ID or passport). The person may also answer identifying questions incorrectly.
