# AIRBORNE PRECAUTIONS

(in addition to Standard Precautions)



STOP VISITORS: Report to nurse before entering.

Use Airborne Precautions as recommended for patients known or suspected to be infected with infectious agents transmitted person-to-person by the airborne route.

#### PATIENT PLACEMENT



Place in an AIIR (Airborne Infection Isolation Room).

Monitor air pressure daily with visual indicators.

Keep door closed when not required for entry and exit.

In ambulatory settings, instruct patients with a known or suspected airborne infection to wear a surgical mask and observe Respiratory Hygiene/Cough Etiquette. Once in an AIIR, the mask may be removed.

## PATIENT TRANSPORT

**Limit transport** to **medically necessary purposes.** If transport outside an AIIR is necessary, instruct patients to **wear a surgical mask**, and observe Respiratory Hygiene/Cough Etiquette.



#### PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

Wear a fit-tested, NIOSH-approved **N95** or higher level respirator for respiratory protection when entering the room of a patient when listed diseases are suspected or confirmed.
