Important Message from Medicare

Your Rights as a Hospital Inpatient:

- You can receive Medicare covered services. This includes medically recessary hospital services and services you may need after you are discharged, if ordered by your doctor. You have a right to know about these services, who will pay for them, and where you can get them.
- You can be involved in any decisions about your hospital stay.
- You can report any concerns you have about the quality of care you receive to your QIO at: LIYANTA 1488-524-9900 or TTY 1488-965-975. The QIO is the independent reviewer authorized by Medicare to review the decision to discharge you.
- You can work with the hospital to prepare for your safe discharge and amange for services you
 may need after you leave the hospital. When you no longer need inputient hospital care, your
 doctor or the hospital staff will inform you of your planned discharge date.
- You can speak with your doctor or other hospital staff if you have concerns about being decharged.

Your Right to Appeal Your Hospital Discharge:

- You have the right to an immediate, independent medical review (appeal) of the decision to decharge you from the hospital. If you on this, you will not have to pay for the services you receive during the appeal (except for charges like copays and deductibles).
- If you ofloose to appeal, the independent reviewer will ask for your opinion. The reviewer also will look at your medical records and/or other relevant information. You do not have to prepare anything in writing, but you have the right to do so if you wish.

explanation about why your covered hospital stay should not continue. You will receive the detailed notice only after you request an appeal.

- If the QIO finds that you are not ready to be discharged from the hospital, Medicare will continue to cover your hospital services.
- If the QIO agrees services should no longer be covered after the discharge date, neither Medicare not your Medicare health plan will pay for your hospital stay after noon of the day after the QIO notifies you of its decision. If you stop services no later than that time, you will avoid financial liability.
- If you do not appeal, you may have to pay for any services you receive after your discharge date.
