WHAT IS A CARDIAC CATHETERIZATION?

Cardiac Catheterization is an X-ray procedure that allows your physician to determine the condition of your blood vessels.

Cardiac Catheterization is often the only way your physician can diagnose narrowing of blood vessels, hardening of the heart valves, or defects in the walls between the chambers of the heart. It also measures your heart's ability to pump blood. Most often the test is used to diagnose coronary artery disease, a narrowing or blockage of the arteries that supply the heart with blood.
