MAKO ROBOTIC-ARM ASSISTED TECHNOLOGY

McLaren Northern Michigan Orthopedic Services specializes in Mako robotic-arm assisted joint replacement procedure. It is designed to relieve the pain caused by joint degeneration due to arthritis. By selectively targeting the damaged cartilage, the surgeon can spare the healthy bone and ligaments surrounding the arthritic portion of the joint. Robotic-arm assisted technology provides your surgeon a patient-specific 3-D model to pre-plan your joint replacement. During the procedure, tactile, visual, auditory feedback, and real-time data assists your surgeon in preparing the replacement and placing the implants in the desired orientation with more accuracy.
