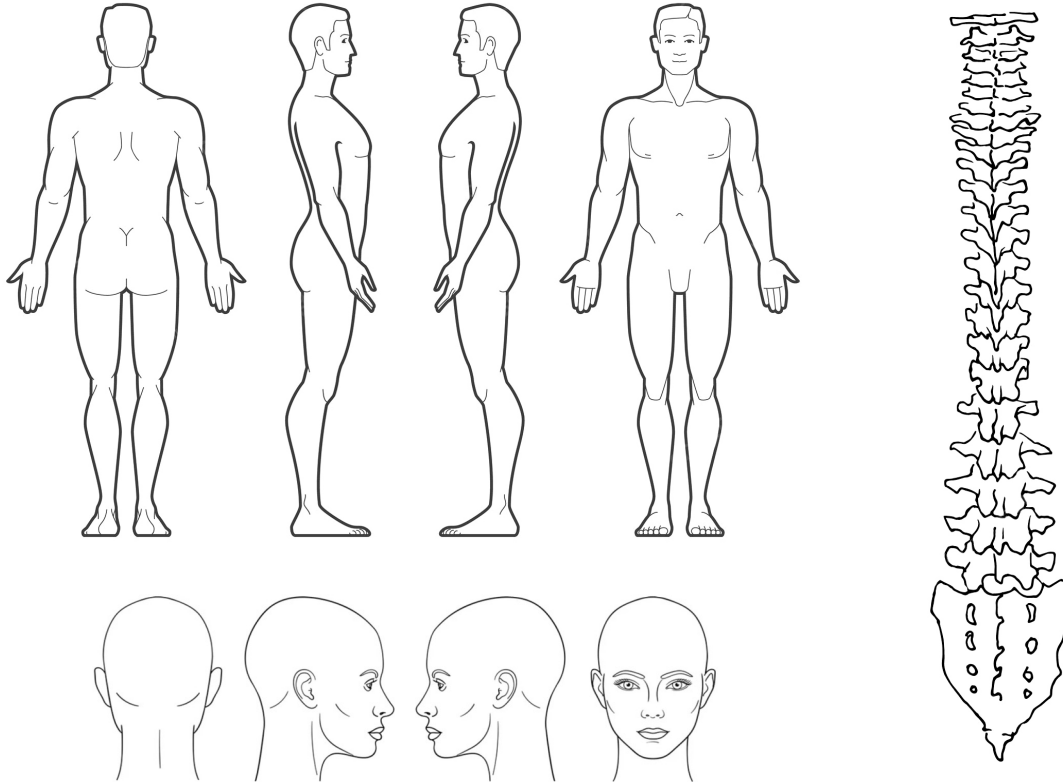


## Alternative Site Marking



Indicate Site(s) on diagram with initials or “Yes” at approximate incision site.

The Alternative site marking shall be used when:

- The patient refused site marking. Risk, Benefits, and Alternatives of site marking explained to the patient by the physician performing the procedure.
- The procedure is one in which site marking is technically or anatomically impossible or impractical to mark the site, including but not limited to mucosal surfaces, perineum, or premature infants.
