STROKE PLAN OF CARE McLaren

When to Initiate Neuro Power Plan and Stroke Quality Documentation

- On admission of patient with diagnosis or suspected diagnosis of TIA or Stroke (ischemic or hemorrhagic)
- Patient is admitted with risk of Stroke, unless Stroke has been ruled out for another diagnosis
- Following an Inpatient Rapid Response/Code Stroke Activation
- After imaging with incident/bedside findings of a Stroke
- Thrombolysis administered for suspected stroke
- Following evaluation at any high-risk transfer procedure

When to do Yale Swallow Screen (Bedside Swallow Screen):

- To be completed by RN within 2400 (4:00 PM) unless if suspected stroke work-up is in progress and 24 hours thereafter unless advised - Please complete Swallow screen prior to administering any PO medications
- Record result of swallow screen in stroke quality documentation based on full face form
- Document pass or fail and ensure time is correctly entered - Completion time documented prior to any and feeds or fluids
- If patient passes, patient may advance diet and fluids per provider order

My Patient has Failed Their Swallow Screen... Now What?

- Notify NPI
- See order about automatically generated "N" in documentation in the Stroke Quality Documentation Tab
- If the order is not generated, search swallow
- Select the Report: RN/PT/Non Stroke Swallow Test and Feed
- Place in comments that patient is NPI/PO needs pending the swallow evaluation
- After completion of the swallow evaluation, review recommendations from the Speech Language Pathologist regarding individualized patient with swallow challenges and add modification if needed
- Modifyling diet and fluid consistency in table of RN orders of practice

Stroke Care Measures Embedded Within the Following Power Plans:

- Neuro Ischemic Stroke TIA was Thrombolysis (Adult or Paediatric Power plan) (Approved)
 - NIH Penetration Assessment Stroke/TIA (Neurological status and follow up orders)
- Neuro Hemorrhagic Stroke (Adult or Paediatric Power Plan)
 - NIH Penetration Assessment (Neurological or Bedside/Head) Hemorrhage
- EE Activated Stroke Risk (Stroke)
- Neuro Hospital Activated Stroke Risk (Stroke)

Required Stroke Quality Measure

- VTE Prophylaxis by Hospital Day 2
- Discharge home on antithrombotic medications
- Anticoagulation for current or history of atrial fibrillation
- Thrombolysis Therapy within 1 hour of arrival
- NIHSS within 10 hours of arrival
- Antithrombotic therapy for hospital day 2
- Assessment for Rehab
- Discharge home on a state license state F/G/H, or T/U
- Documentation of Stroke Education
- Spinalgia screening before PO
- Local panel (SIC) within 48 hours of admission
- Discharge medication (DMJ) completed prior to discharge or within 30 days of admission
- Case Management End and Follow Up

Initiate a Rapid Response/Code Stroke Activation per facility Stroke Algorithm for any new sudden onset of neurological deficits or a change in NIHSS of 1 or more.
