## ELIGIBILITY

If you have Medicare and two or more chronic health conditions, some examples of which are listed below, you may benefit from the Chronic Care Management program.

- Alzheimer's
- Arthritis
- Atrial fibrillation
- Autism spectrum disorders
- Cancer
- Cardiovascular disease

- COPD
- Depression
- Diabetes
- Hypertension or high blood pressure

## WHAT IS THE COST?

Depending on insurance coverage, there may be a minimal coinsurance or no out-of-pocket cost to receive chronic care management. Patients can call their insurance to determine coverage.

As a chronic care management coordinator, Janie will be your point of contact regarding any new or worsening symptoms related to your illness. While your primary care provider (PCP) will continue to oversee your care, Janie will check in more frequently on your health and communicate any changes to your PCP and the Chronic Care Management team.
