What is Colon Cancer Screening?

- A colonoscopy is performed to screen for colorectal cancer. During this process, a small flexible tube with a camera at the tip is inserted into the rectum to detect abnormalities in the large intestine and rectum. Patients are sedated for this procedure.

What Are the Symptoms of Colon Cancer?

- The most common symptom is a change in bowel habits, such as diarrhea, constipation or blood in the stool.
- Other symptoms include cramping or pain in the lower abdominal (stomach) area, constant tiredness or lack of energy.
- Early colon cancer has no symptoms, so regular screening is vital for early detection.
