What are the risks of anesthesia?

White anesthesia is usually very safe, no procedure is without some degree of risk, and your anesthesiologist will discuss this with you prior to your surgery. Nausea or vomiting may be related to anesthesia, the type of surgical procedure, or postoperative pain medications. You should discuss any concerns with your anesthesiologist.

After the procedure

When the surgery is complete, the anesthesia medications are stopped, and you will slowly wake in the operating or recovery room. You'll probably feel groggy and a little confused when you first wake.

You may experience common side effects such as:

Nausea

Shivering

Vomiting

Sleepiness

Dry Mouth

Mid hourseness

Sore throat.

You may also experience other side effects after you awaken from anesthesia. Side effects depend on your individual condition and type of surgery. Your doctor may give you medications after your procedure to reduce pain and nausea.
